Core tasks

UMC Utrecht offers basic-specialist care as well as advanced care requiring extraordinary knowledge or expertise, it performs leading scientific research, and offers excellent education for students, researchers, physicians and other healthcare providers.

Strategic research programs

- *Brain*: ADHD, autism, bipolar disorders, schizophrenia, ALS
- *Child Health*: chronic inflammation, respiratory infections, stem cell therapy for rare diseases, fertility disorders
- *Circulatory Health*: atherosclerosis, heart failure, stroke
- *Infection and Immunity*: antibiotic resistance, opportunistic infections, immune deficiencies, chronic inflammation
- *Personalized Cancer Care*: breast cancer, gastrointestinal cancer, head-neck cancer
- *Regenerative Medicine & Stem Cells*: stem cell therapy, tissue regeneration for musculoskeletal purposes and the heart

Quality and patient safety

In July 2016, the accreditation of the in 2013 awarded international JCI quality certificate was extended for another 3 years. For this accreditation, the hospital was audited on more than 1400 aspects of quality of care, research and education. The number of reports of hospital emergencies submitted to the Dutch Health Inspectorate has been increasing for a number of years, whereas hospital mortality and number of complaints reported to the complaint handling department have been stable.
