Core tasks

UMC Utrecht offers basic-specialist care as well as advanced care requiring extraordinary knowledge or expertise, it performs leading scientific research, and offers excellent education for students, researchers, physicians and other healthcare providers.

Strategic research programs

- *Brain*: stroke, epilepsy, muscle diseases (ALS), psychotic diseases (schizophrenia en bipolar disorder), developmental disorders (ADHD and autism)
- *Child Health*: chronic inflammation, respiratory infections, stem cell therapy for rare diseases, fertility disorders
- *Circulatory Health*: atherosclerosis, heart failure, stroke
- *Infection and Immunity*: opportunistic infections, immune deficiencies, chronic inflammation
- *Personalized Cancer Care*: breast cancer, gastrointestinal cancer, head-neck cancer
- *Regenerative Medicine & Stem Cells*: stem cell therapies, tissue regeneration for musculoskeletal purposes and the heart

Quality

As the first hospital in the Netherlands, UMC Utrecht was awarded in 2013 the international JCI quality certificate according to the new accreditation standards. For this accreditation, the hospital was audited on more than 1400 quality aspects related to care, research and education.

Sustainability

Sustainability is a central theme within the strategy. UMC Utrecht uses 100 percent green electricity, water is being separated in 20 different groups, and water-saving measures are being taken. About 65 percent of employees commutes to work by bike or by public transportation.
